
HOW TO PLAY

Language is important. We sometimes hear and use words without fully understanding their meaning. This game helps students better understand the nuance and complexity of language and vocabulary. Each card has a vocabulary word and prompt to facilitate a discussion around the use and meaning of the vocabulary word. We've left a blank page for you to make your own.

- Organize students in pairs or small groups. Give each a vocabulary card.
- Give students ten minutes (you can adapt the time) to discuss the prompt. How accurate are the statements?



DEBATE PROMPT

Use the sentence to start a discussion on the meaning of the word, how people use it, and how accurately it is used.

- Now give groups five minutes (you can adapt the time) to share with the large group what the uncovered. Does the word get properly used?
- Facilitate a class discussion around the game. What did they learn?
